As readers we will be:

Using our knowledge of predicting, questioning, summarising and clarifying to read and understand *The Something* by Rebecca Cobb.

As writers we will be:

We will be enjoying and discussing the books *The Stone Age Boy* by Satoshi Kitamura and *Ug* by Raymond Briggs. We will be using the books to write a short story about the Stone Age, using all of our skills and knowledge to help us. Additionally, we will be writing a non-chronological report about life in the Stone Age.

As mathematicians we will be:

We will be using our maths mastery knowledge to learn about place value. The children will be able to count in multiples of 100's and 50's.

In Computing we will be:

We will be learning about different types of technology. We will also be creating a PowerPoint about the Stone Age.

As musicians we will be:

Learning to sing and also play the song, *Let Your Spirit Fly*.

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In French we will be:

Learning about France as a country and learning common phrases such as, how to say your name and how you are.

In RE we will be looking at:

We are learning about the religious festival, Diwali and the children will learn the variety of ways that people celebrate this festival.

As scientists we will be:

We will be studying animals, including humans. The children will look at the animal skeleton and understand which of those animals are invertebrates and vertebrates.

As artists and designers we will be:
