As readers we will be:

Using our knowledge of predicting, questioning, summarising and clarifying to read and understand The Iron Man by Ted Hughes



As writers we will be:

We will be enjoying and discussing the book Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl. We will be creating our own newspaper report of Charlie winning the golden ticket and writing a story of our own to link the Willy Wonka. We will be using our Year 4 expectations whilst writing our assessed pieces.

As artists and designers we will be:

We will be making and evaluating our own French bread to link with our curriculum

As mathematicians we will be:

Using our maths mastery knowledge to learn about further multiplication and division. The children will use various methods to help them learn how to multiply and divide their numbers up to the 12 times table. They will also learn about remainders in their division.



In computing we will be:

We will be learning about different types of technology. We will also be presenting and creating our own data.

In French we will be:

Learning about France as a country and learning common phrases such as, how to say your name, how you are, where you live and who your family are.

In RE we will be looking at:

We will be focusing on the religion Christianity, in particular we will be looking at the theme of Christmas and our main concept is focusing on the incarnation.

As musicians we will be:

Learning to play and compose songs using the trumpets.

Curriculum
