<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identify and name a variety of common animals, including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals</li><li>• Identify and name a variety of animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores</li><li>• Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals</li><li>• Explore and answer questions about animals in their habitats</li><li>• Understand how to take care of animals</li><li>• Group animals according to what they eat</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Know what a <b>pet</b> is</li><li>• Name some <b>common animals</b> that can be kept as pets – dog, cat, rabbit, guinea pig, hamster and fish</li><li>• Know what a <b>mammal</b> is</li><li>• Name some common UK mammals – fox, badger, hedgehog, rabbit, deer, mouse</li><li>• Know what a <b>bird</b> is</li><li>• Name some common UK birds – pigeon, blackbird, owl, blue tit, robin, seagulls</li><li>• Know what a <b>reptile</b> is</li><li>• Name some common UK reptiles – lizard, adders</li><li>• Know what a <b>fish</b> is</li><li>• Name some common UK fish – pike, carp, roach</li><li>• Know what an <b>amphibian</b> is</li><li>• Name some common UK amphibians – toad, frog, newt</li><li>• Know the difference and similarities in <b>appearance</b> and <b>structure</b> of common UK animals (as listed above)</li><li>• Know what a <b>habitat</b> is</li><li>• Know where a range of common UK animals live</li><li>• Know that a <b>carnivore</b> is an animal that eats meat</li><li>• Know that a <b>herbivore</b> is an animal that doesn't eat meat</li><li>• Know that an <b>omnivore</b> is an animal that eats meat and plants (e.g fruit and vegetables)</li><li>• Know that humans are omnivores</li><li>• <b>Classify</b> which group animals named above fall in to</li><li>• Know that animals food, water and shelter to <b>survive</b></li><li>• Know how to take care of different pets</li></ul>
