<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Notice that animals have offspring that grow</li><li>• Find out about the basic needs of animals for survival</li><li>• Describe the importance of eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene</li><li>• Introduced to the process of reproduction and growth in animals</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Know what <b>offspring</b> are</li><li>• Explain why animals have <b>babies</b></li><li>• Know which <b>parent animals</b> have which offspring</li><li>• Know that all animals, including humans, have offspring that grow into <b>adults</b></li><li>• Know that growth from offspring to an adult is a <b>gradual process</b></li><li>• Know the different ways in which animals <b>reproduce</b></li><li>• Know that some animals give birth to <b>live offspring</b> and that some <b>lay eggs</b></li><li>• Use a range of <b>criteria</b> to sort animals</li><li>• Know that animals, including humans, have <b>basic needs</b> to <b>survive</b> – <b>food, water, air</b></li><li>• Know that the <b>environment</b> is a factor of <b>survival</b> for animals, including humans</li><li>• Know what a <b>habitat</b> is</li><li>• Know how a habitat provides some things that animals need</li><li>• Know that animals are best suited to <b>specific environments</b></li><li>• Know that <b>extinct</b> means when a species of animal dies out and there are no more left</li></ul>
