As readers we will be:

Using our knowledge of predicting, questioning, summarising and clarifying to read and understand Fintan Fedora the World's Worst Explorer by Clive Goddard

As writers we will be:

Enjoying and discussing the book Dragons at Crumbling Castle by Terry Pratchett. We will be creating our own biography of an Anglo Saxon and other different pieces of writing, making sure that we are using all of the year 4 expectations that we have learnt so far.

In Computing we will be:

Learning about different types of technology, be presenting and creating our own data. We will also be learning how to use different software on the computer

As mathematicians we will be:

We will be using our maths mastery knowledge to learn about further multiplication and division. We will also be beginning to learn about the use of bar charts and line graphs and also starting fractions.

As musicians we will be:

Learning to play and compose songs using the trumpets.
