**Mountbatten Primary School Behaviour Policy**  
**COVID-19 Annex**

**June 2020**

This annex to the behaviour policy is to ensure the safety of all pupils and staff.

This annex sets out some of the adjustments we are making in line with the changed arrangements in the school and following advice from government in response to COVID-19 and the wider opening of schools.

- Green language will be used to promote the positive behaviour expected in school at this time
- Pupils to adhere to their time slots for arrival and departure at school and to remain 2 metres distance from other pupils arriving and departing at the same time
- Pupils will be directed to wash their hands and sanitise at regular intervals during the school day
- The school has been separated into bubbles of pupils and staff. Pupils must stay within their bubble and not interact with pupils or adults from another bubble.
- Each bubble has been allocated an outdoor space for break times. Pupils should remain in the designated space and remain socially distanced from others in their bubble
- Each pupil will have their own desk and chair in the classroom and their own resources to use. There will be no sharing of resources or equipment.
- In the event of sneezing or coughing, pupils should use a tissue and 'catch it, bin it, kill it' before immediately washing their hands and sanitising
- Pupils should avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with their hands and if they do they will be directed to wash their hands and sanitise immediately
- The number of pupils using the toilets at the same time will be limited to two. Toilets will be supervised to ensure this limit is adhered to and that pupils wash their hands and sanitise
- Spitting or coughing towards any other person will not be tolerated and could put the pupil's placement in school during COVID-19 at risk
- All pupils are expected to follow the guidelines above and to follow instructions given by staff, to ensure the safety of all pupils and staff

If your child does not follow the expectations set out in this policy your child's placement will be at risk. It is paramount at this time that all children and staff are safe at school.
