Phonics

Task 1

1. Sing the alphabet song.
2. Revisit and practice all of the sounds you have learnt so far s, a, t, p, i, n, m and d.
3. Focus on the four new sounds: g, o, c. k. that we learnt last week.
4. Now use these sounds to play I spy with your child "I spy something beginning with 'a' " "apple"
5. Judging your child's knowledge of the sounds they have learnt you can adapt the game for their stage. For example you could go for a walk and play I spy to challenge your child more. If your child is finding it hard to play I spy you could find 5 objects that start with different letters, cover the objects with a blanket and remove one from the group "the object missing begins with an 'a'" "apple".
6. We would love to see photos on Tapestry of the objects you can find using your initial sounds.

Continue to practise blending and segmenting the previous words from last week.



Challenge!

Can your child segment the objects they find whilst playing I spy?

Eg- "I spy with my little eye something beginning with

c"

"Cat"

"How do you spel cat?"

"C-a-t"

Maths

Task 1 –

1. Recite numbers to 20. Continue to practise this everyday encouraging your child to count as high as they can.
2. Can you go on a shape hunt? This can be done inside or outside. Use the song provided to encourage your child to find the shapes. You could use the following shapes on your hunt- circle, triangle, square, rectangle oval, star, pentagon.

Challenge!

Why not use the shapes found to create a picture, this could be with objects or drawing. Don't forget to upload your pictures onto tapestry!

Other areas of learning

Task 1 – PE – Animal Movements

1. Encourage your child to move like different animals.
Can you be a snake and slither across the floor? Can you be an elephant and make big stomping steps?
Can you hop like a frog?
2. Can you challenge your child how they might think a sloth or a cheetah might move? Fast or slow?

Task 2 – Art & PSHCE- making a family tree

Can you make a family tree?

You could use photos of your family or you could draw them.

If you have paints, why not get messy and paint a family tree.

Whilst making the family tree discuss with your child who is in the family and how they are related to your child.

Challenge!
Your child might say that they are missing these family members, why not make them a beautiful picture and post it to them to brighten up their day.



Task 3- Being Imaginative

Can you use your imagination to role play with your child?

Role play is a vital part of a child's learning and it can be done in so many ways!

You could have a tea party, play builders, put on a show, go on a dinosaur adventure.

The possibilities are endless, don't worry if you don't have the props you can improvise. Why not use 2 loo roll tubes for binoculars or use old clothes to create costumes?



Challenge!

Why not add a story line to the play following your child's lead.

"I've just been to the moon to get some cheese in my rocket and I met a alien".

Let your imaginations run wild!
