## As scientists we will be:

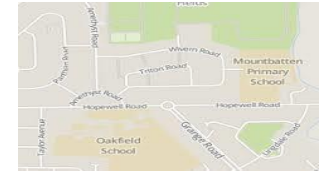
- Learning about the names of parts of our bodies
