## PE

## Reading books

## As readers we will be:



- Enjoying reading 'This Morning I Met A Whale' by Michael Morpurgo. The children will be clarifying words, finding evidence in our class read and answering a range of retrieval questions.

## As writers we will be:

- Writing a narrative, newspaper article and poetry based on our Reading text by Michael Morpurgo.

## In French we will be:

- Developing our vocabulary by learning greetings, colours and numbers in French.

## As mathematicians we will be:



- Learning numbers to 1000 including addition and subtraction of 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. We will also begin to solve word problems using these operations.

## In History/Geography we will:

- Study life in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age investigating what life was like for people in this period.
